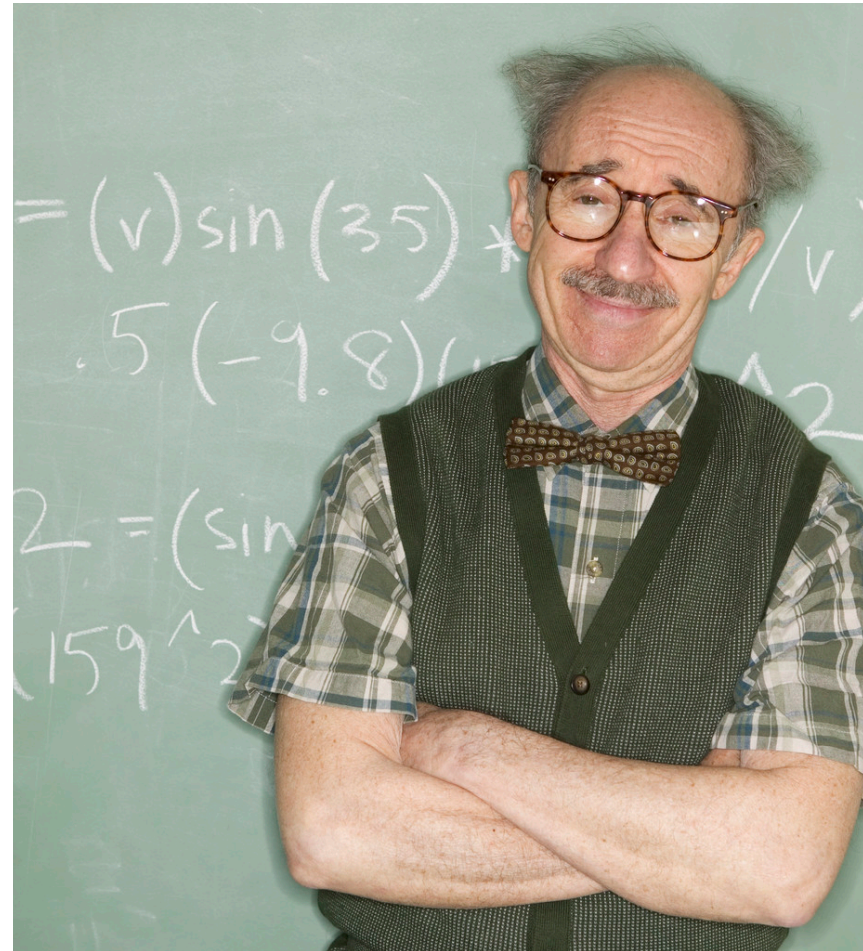

The material in the philosophical section is quite extensive and detailed

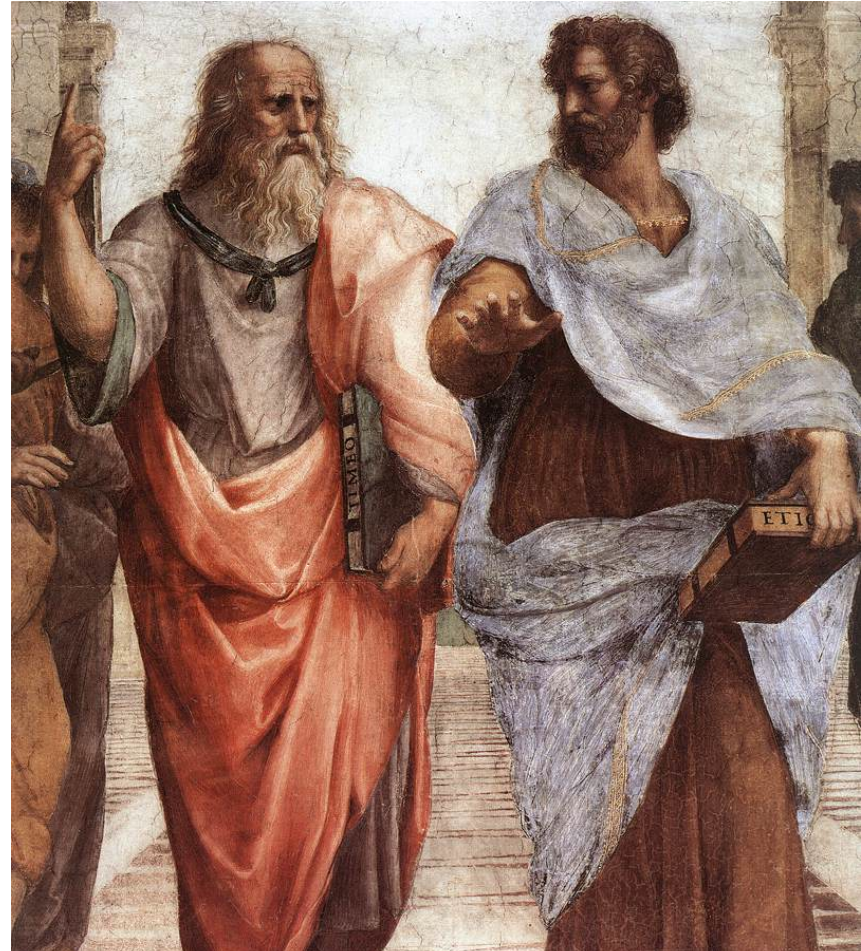
You can go through the course in **two different ways** depending on your background and what it is that you would like to focus on.



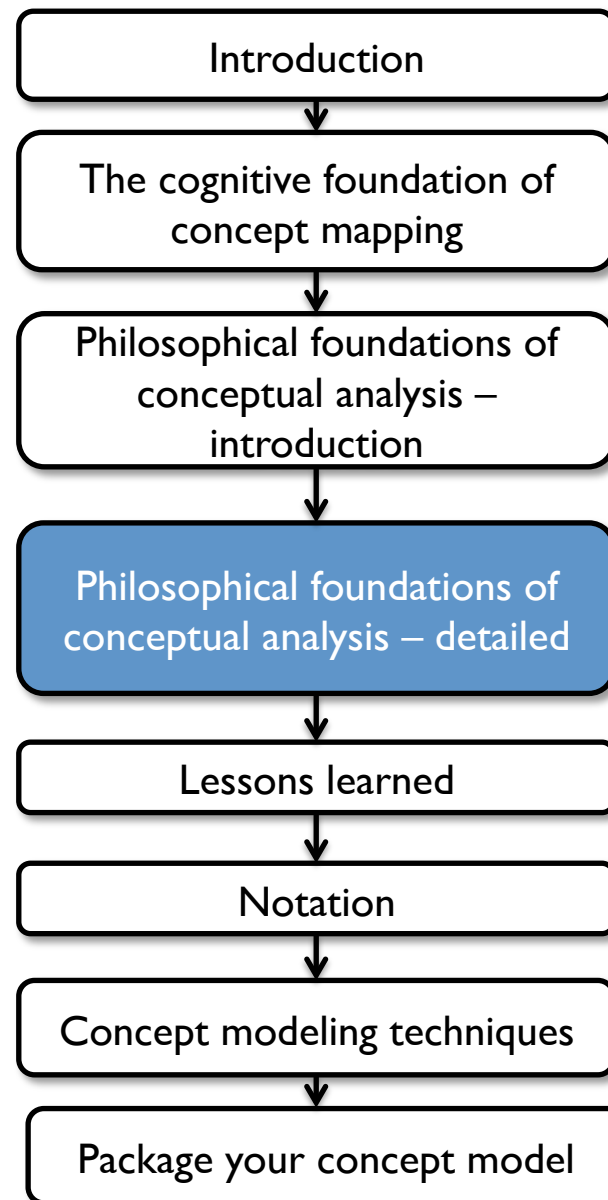
# Option one
